A brand new tweeter design - comprising of a soft dome HF driver coupled to an elliptical waveguide - has been optimised to provide very controlled high frequency directivity and minimise diffraction,

providing a wide and consistent listening field.

The new Reveals feature front-firing reflex bass ports, negating the inherent problem of bass-coupling. This allows for ideal positioning even within small or confined studio spaces, while still providing well defined bass performance.

#### **Reveal Passive**

The passive Reveal 601p packs performance, accuracy and value into a compact enclosure. Priced competitively with the serious home or project studio setup in mind, the all new Reveal 601p delivers a wide bandwidth performance that will impress even the most seasoned pro.
